ACTIVITIES REPORT 2015-2016



JANASADHANA

Janasadhana is a state level organization has been involved in different welfare activities for the development of backward and needy people in different parts of Odisha. Especially it has been working for the up-gradation of artisans, weavers, unemployed youths, tribal people and women SHGs. The organization has under taken various programmes in the financial year (2015-16).

Handicraft Sector:

In Handicraft Sector it is involved in Handicraft Cluster Development Project participated by 500 Nos of Stone Carving Artisans in Soro & Oupada Block of Balasore district. The Programme is sponsored by Ministry of Textiles, Govt. of India. Besides that we are involved in other Handicraft items like Terracotta, Appliqué work, Wooden Toy, Docra Items etc. Besides providing Training, we are involved in other activities like production, marketing with the involvement of trained Artisans.

Handloom Activities:

Similarly we are also engaging the trained weavers after providing them training in production of Handloom materials like Sarees, Scarf, lungi, Dhoti, Bedsheet, Door Screen etc. and also providing them market facilities in both local market, exhibition, and out of the state. In both the cases the Artisans and the weavers are being benefited as they are getting their daily bread and increasing their socio economic standard.

SHG Promotion:

We are engaged in empowerment of women in different backward Blocks like Similiguda and Boipariguda block of Koraput District, Papadahandi Block of Nabarangapur District, Daringbadi and Kothogada Blocks of Kandhamal District, Bisamcuttack and Ramanaguda Blocks of Rayagada District.

Plantation programme:

Since 2001 we have been involved in Plantation and its preservation programme particularly in the area where deforestation is increasing due to shift Cultivation. Misuse of forest products and lack of proper maintenance in the mining areas as well as in hilly areas also. In 2012-13 we have planted around 6000 plants of variety species in different villages of Joda Badbil of Keonjhar District, Mohana of Gajapati District, and Astaranga of Puri District. In addition to it we have formed 20 numbers of Bana Surakshya Samiti and aware them for the maintenance of forest under our *Social Forestry Programme*.

Health & sanitation Programme:

The Organization on its prior basis has been involved in implementing different programmes related to health and sanitation. It has organized awareness programmes on Health and sanitation for the people living in inaccessible villages in remote areas in Bhanjanagar, Aska, Belaguntha of Ganjam District, Biridi Block of Jagatsinghpur

District, Bologada and Begunia Blocks of Khurda District, Banki and Baranga Block of Cuttack District, Nimapada and Astaranga Block of Puri District.

We have aware the people, Children in villages, in schools for use of latrines, pure drinking water and clean utensils and clothes. In 2013-14 we have also involved the Slums in cities like Cuttack and Bhubaneswar as well as the Small Cities like Bhawanipatna, Rourkela, Jaipur etc in our Health and Sanitation Programme. Besides that we have organized Health Camps, Blood Donation Camps, and Eye Camps in slum areas.

Targeted Intervention Project (TI):

We are implementing TI project for continuous **last five years** for **MSM** and **FSW** in **Bhanjanagar**, **Belaguntha and Aska** block of **Ganjam** district sponsored by **OSACS** as a part of our program for prevention and control of HIV/ Aids. We are involved in counseling, blood testing, condom distribution etc.

Agriculture and allied activities:

Involvement in agriculture and allied activities is a part of our livelihood programme to facilitate the people attached with the sector which is one of our prime agenda since 2001. This year the organization implemented various programmes such as trainings, cultivation, exposure visit of farmer, formation of farmers clubs and their orientation related to agriculture and allied activities such as transplantation programs, line rowing plantation, mixed crop plantation, management of Pani Panchayat, training on vermin compost, use of bio fertilizer, etc. besides that we have supported the women farmer groups through training and financial arrangement with bank linkages for backyard poultry farming, mushroom plantation, cultivation of vegetables and oil seeds etc. in different districts like Jagatsinghpur, Kandhamal, Balasore, Khurda, Ganjam, Gajapati, etc.

Skill Development Training Program:

Our organization is involved in providing different skill development training program for unemployed, semi- employed people belongs to different groups such as youths, women, on different trades for their self employment.

We provided training in IT sector more than five hundred trainees in block head quarters and made arrangements for their employments in different sectors as well as self employment. Similarly we are provided training on mobile repairing, TV repairing, motorcycle repairing, plumbering, readymade garment making in different districts.

Adult Education Program:

We are running adult education centers in different rural areas in Kandhamal, Jagatsingpur, Cuttack districts in Odisha. Near about three hundred adults learners are being benefited in twelve numbers of centers.

Tribal Development Program:

We have provided skill up gradation training program to unemployed tribal youths in Baipariguda block of Koraput district on different trades like mobile repairing, TV repairing, motorcycle repairing, plumbering etc.

ASHA HBNC Programme:

The organization is involved in the above programme in the year 2013-14 and successfully completed **26 batches** of training under **6&7th module**. Second round training has been completed. Under this programme training lodging & boarding facilities has been provided to **35 nos** of trainees in a batch. The organization has developed its training site at **Athagada block** head quarter of **Cuttack district**. Improving maternal and new born health, child health and nutrition status are in the training course. The aim and objective of the programme is **reducing IMR & MMR** in the state of Odisha.

Schedule caste Cluster Development Programme:

The organization has undertaken Cluster Development Programme for Schedule Caste community at **Kujanga block** of **Jagatsinghpur** district. Under these programme **226 SC** beneficiaries has been selected in **Biswali village**. Financial benefits will be given to the households by providing support and skill in backyard poultry, goatary, diary, fishery, craft and agriculture. The project will continue for three years and is supported by **OSFDC** (**Odisha Schedule Caste Financial Development Corporation**).

Legal Awareness Programme For Women:

Legal awareness programme was organized in Biswali and Kothi villages of Kujanga Block in Jagatsinghpur District separately sponsored by National Commission for Women, Govt of India.120nos of participants participated in the 2programmes, educated on different legal components of Govt of India on the rights of women in society. Besides this the programme was participated by local representatives like Sarpanch, ward members, SHGs and other distinguished persons of the area.

Training of ANMs on HBNC Programme:

In order to provide hand holding support to ASHAs for effectiveness of HBNC programme and strengthening of ASHAs involvement in field activities ANMs in Banki Block were provided training by Janasadhana sponsored by NRHM, Cuttack.

Ama Janagala Yojana:

The organization has undertaken Ama Jangala Yojana at Panposh & Bisra ranges for Rourkela forest division.

Rural development Programme:

The development of a Nation or the state like odisha where 80% population live in rural areas depends upon the all round development of villages. Realizing this aspects the organization has been working for then integrated sustainable development of villages in backward districts like koraput, kandhamal, kalahandi, and other undeveloped blocks since 2003. The development includes the development of infrastructural facilities like roads, drinking water facilities, community halls, as well as income generation facilities for the villagers in villages.

Conclusion:

Our main objective is to provide service to the needy groups who are being left of different facilities provided by government and other agencies as well as upgrade the socio economic standard of poor people particular in backward and remote areas.
