JANASADHANA

Janasadhana is a state level organization has been working in different sectors for the down trodden groups all over the odisha since 2001. It has the experience in handling different projects in partnership with Govt. of India, State Govt. & other private entrepreneurship agencies.

Ama Janagala Yojana:

The organization is working as a partner NGO for Ama Jangal Yojana (AJY) project under Rourkela forest division in Panposh & Bisra range from 2015. Different Activities like formation of VSS, Preparation and execution of Micro plan, GPS modeling, JFM Activities were undertaking in this project. The different parameters related to activities undertaken to form Vana Surakhya Samities, to build its capacity, understanding of AJY parameters by the VSSs, involvement in Micro Plan preparation by the VSS, Participating in different Soil & Moisture Conservation activities, forest cleaning and deweeding activities, no of Self Help Groups in every VSS, their linkage with Banks and income generation activates undertaken by them, Convergence work in different VSS. We are working with 51nos of VSS in the two ranges.

Schedule caste Cluster Development Programme:

The organization has undertaken Cluster Development Programme for Schedule Caste community at **Kujanga block** of **Jagatsinghpur** district with the support of **OSFDC**, **Govt. of Odisha**. Under these programme **226 SC** beneficiaries under BPL category has been selected in **Biswali GP of Kujanga block**. The beneficiaries are being financed by OSFDC for their integrated & socio-economic development through supporting their traditional & professional occupation like backyard poultry, goatary, diary, fishery, craft and agriculture, under the guidance of JANASADHANA. The outcome of this project is very much satisfactory as the economical standard of the beneficiary families is being upgraded. We hope for a better change in their social & economical status with the implementation of this project.

SHG Development Programme:

The organization has a long history of engagement with SHGs in different parts of Odisha for their all round development in partnership with both Govt. & Private sectors. The different programme has been undertaken includes motivation, Awarness, vocational training programme, capacity building training programme and provision of financial assistance.

Now the organization has been assigned for the formation, Bank linkage, Capacity Building of SHGs in 16 NACs of Ganjam District, By State Urban Development Agency

(SUDA), Govt. of Odisha and it is engaged in formation and promotion of Area Level Federation (ALF) in the said district. Besides this the organization is involved in providing alternative income generation facilities in various fields for the SHGs in other Districts with the objective of self reliance of SHGs.

Seminar on Discrimination and Economical Development of SC in Odisha:

We have conducted a seminar on Social Discrimination & economical development of SC in odisha. on 27th February 2019 (Wednesday) at 10:00 AM at IDCOL Auditorium, Bhubaneswar where **Dr. Yogendra Paswan**, Hon'ble Member, National Commission for Scheduled Castes, Government of India, New Delhi will be the as Chief Guest. Senior officers from State government, Banks and representative of SC/ST Associations have participated in this Seminar. 200nos of participants representating different SC communities all over the Odisha attended the Seminars. They share their comments & experience on the said topic. The seminar was appraised by everyone present in the meeting. Dr. Paswan listened to the problems related to SC community in Odisha from the attendance & assured them to takes steps for solution of their problems.

Base line Survey:

The organization has a vast experience of conducting different type of survey on various issues. Social Impact Assessment Survey in Koira Tahasil under bonai subdivision of Sundargarh District. Covering 1215 household in 19 villages in partnership with MG Mohnaty Iron Mines. The present socio-economic status of the core area and the effect of CSR on the people have been studied in the year.

The methodology it adopts like PRA & RRA methods for Socio-economic environment Impact Assessment study. Group discussions, One to One discussions, and House to House survey as well as village level meeting are the different measures it undertakes for the study in order to prepare a plan to solve the problems faced by the concerned projects at site. Identification of affected population and their mobilization for preparation of the plan are also the part of the study. Besides their possession in kind of land, livestock's, transport facilities, Trees, Households and other family assets the basic infrastructural facilities like Health, Sanitation, Environment, Education, Drinking water and Irrigational facilities, the communication facilities like road, telephone and power facilities are taken in to consideration during the study.

Agriculture and allied activities:

Involvement in agriculture and allied activities is a part of our livelihood programme to facilitate the people attached with the sector which is one of our prime agenda since 2001. This year the organization implemented various programmes such as trainings, cultivation, exposure visit of farmer, formation of farmers clubs and their orientation related to agriculture and allied activities such as transplantation programs, line rowing plantation, mixed crop plantation, management of Pani Panchayat, training on vermin compost, use of bio fertilizer, etc. besides that we have supported the women farmer groups through training and financial arrangement with bank linkages for backyard poultry farming, mushroom plantation, cultivation of vegetables and oil seeds etc. in different districts like Jagatsinghpur, Kandhamal, Balasore, Khurda, Ganjam, Gajapati, etc.

Conclusion:

Our main objective is to provide service to the needy groups who are being left of different facilities provided by government and other agencies as well as upgrade the socio economic standard of poor people particular in backward and remote areas.
